

CLEAR III DOSING SCHEDULES

The tables show the dosing patterns depending on what time you start dose. Pick a start time along the row for dose 1 and read **down the column** to see the day-night schedule based on that start time. The table includes two days of dosing to show you the rhythm of the cycle.

The times within the orange border are the better times to start drug, leaving you with only one scheduled dose during the night at a time not more than eight hours after the pharmacy closing time (hours to drug expiry).

I added the row of 5:00 pm pharmacy closing times to show how long from closing to next dose to exhibit how many hours between 5 pm delivery and next dose. Starting first dose in the orange zone assures that delivered drug can be given within the next 8 hrs, whereas this cannot be guaranteed in the brown zones.
